

Driving Directions to Crane Lake Discovery Camp

Google directions are excellent.

Destination: 200 South Crane Lake Rd, MacTier, Ontario

Note: if you enter 200 Crane Lake Road as your destination, you will end up at the other end of the lake. Then you'll have another hour of driving back to the camp.

Google DIRECTIONS	NOTES
Take Hwy ON-401 East to Hwy ON-400 North.	
Take Hwy ON-400 North through Barrie.	
When Hwy ON-400 splits, keep RIGHT at the fork to stay on Hwy ON-400.	Follow signs for ON-69 / Parry Sound / Sudbury (ON-69 has been renamed Lake Joseph Rd, but not all the signs show that).
Take Exit 189 for MacTier.	Follow signs for Lake Joseph Rd, MacTier and Gravenhurst.
Go STRAIGHT, merging onto Lake Joseph Road (formerly Hwy ON-69).	
Turn LEFT onto Muskoka Road 11.	Continue on this road, watching for the blue sign for <i>District Parry Sound</i> . Slow down when you see it; your next turn is just past this.
Turn LEFT onto Healey Lake Road.	·
Turn RIGHT onto South Crane Lake Road.	You are now on a gravel road. It is about a half-hour drive on this road until you reach the camp. Call 705-378-1870 or text staff if you run into problems on your way in.
Keep LEFT whenever you have a choice in the lane unless signs tell you otherwise.	The first half of the road is maintained by the Cottager's Association and the last half of the road is private to the camp.
